


MBH Series Band Heaters






Installation

Band heaters should be clamped securely to the object to be heated and mounted so that they are not tilted in assembly, but are placed squarely against the surface to be heated. Air gaps as a result of poor clamping result in poor heat transfer, excessive heat loss, and short heater life.





Band heaters should be clamped securely to the surface to be heated, run at operating temperature, and retightened to correct for the effects of expansion.

Each half of the two-piece band heaters are rated 120 Volts, and are wired in parallel for 120 Volt operation, or in series for 240 Volt operation. When heating objects to higher temperatures, lower watt density heaters should be used to prevent overheating and shortened heater life. Watt density is the total wattage of the heater divided by the heated surface area of the heater. Use the table below to select the maximum recommended watt density for the application.

WARRANTY

OMEGA warrants this unit to be free of defects in materials and workmanship and to give satisfactory service for a period of 13 months from date of purchase. OMEGA Warranty adds an additional one (1) month grace period to the normal one (1) year product warranty to cover handling and shipping time.
