

California Proposition 65 – Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 Statement

Overview

California Proposition 65 - *Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986* requires businesses to provide warnings regarding products containing chemical substances known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm to the consumer. Further, California Proposition 65 requires the State of California to publish a list of these chemical substances. The list of substances, which must be updated at least once per year, is maintained by the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA).

DwyerOmega and its affiliated brands are global leaders in sensing, monitoring and control technologies. As such, DwyerOmega is committed to minimizing the environmental impact (including the impact caused by the chemical substances defined by California Proposition 65) associated with the manufacture of our products.

This statement does not replace warnings which may appear on or with a product, or the product's marketing material.

Company Statement

DwyerOmega has reviewed the California Proposition 65 *Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act* and based this statement on Title 27, California Code of Regulations Article 6 – *Clear and Reasonable Warnings and the* OEHHA list of substances and endpoints. DwyerOmega has reviewed the impact on its products and determined that it complies with the existing California Proposition 65 legislation with regard to presenting clear and reasonable warning to our customers. DwyerOmega will continue to monitor the legislation as well as the review of its product offerings. Any future updates may require changes in this statement and/or product warning methods.
