

Statement of Compliance with Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)

Overview

Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 about persistent organic pollutants (POPs) deals with the protection of the human health and the environment against these substances by a preferably early elimination of production or accordingly by the limitation to a minimum regarding manufacturing, placing on the market and usage of these substances.

Furthermore, the regulation defines provisions about waste which consist of these substances, in which these substances are contained, or which are contaminated by these substances.
